Job purpose

You will provide management and leadership support to the Team Leader, including appraisals, training, and development to ensure that applicable levels of skilled competence are maintained by the Team Leader and their direct reports.

Technical

Responsible for conducting a range of technical assurance activities to ensure standards are worked to and the service delivered is fully compliant.

Attend, when necessary, factory acceptance tests and site acceptance tests.

Compliance

Ensure compliance to GSK & EMCOR UK standards.

Ensure that all employees and contractors under your direct control work to GSK Quality, Environmental and Health & Safety procedure.

To ensure zero failed metrics across the agreed contract metrics defined in the GSK/EMCOR UK Contract Metrics Guide.

Resource responsibilities

To have the direct line management of the LEV team.

Ability to lead and manage a team, while managing and planning your own workload.

You will need to be flexible to support this and other accounts as required.
